 - Key points:
 - -Explained the introduction of the new achievement chord vs honour chord (categories, application process, etc)
 - -Nicole M-S suggested giving FI graduates a pin to wear to honour/acknowledge graduates...this idea was discouraged by DA
- -Open for input from committee
- -Nicole shared ideas from other southern interior school districts
 - -Special dinner for FI staff & graduates
 - -« Nuit Blanche » everyone dresses in white, fancy meal
 - -Pin from Canadian Parents for French

Studen voice:

Parent Voice:

Teacher Voice:

- -Make sure to explain the meaning of Dual Dogwood to audience (Established title of « French Immersion Dual Dogwood »)
- -The program should is not comparable to other programs like Trades. This is a K-12 commitment with big effort and sacrifices

Admin Voice:

- -New Achievement Cord idea was in progress last year
- -Would like to acknowledge more that academic achievements
- -Shine a light on greatness areas/kids doing great things going above & beyond
- -What represents you the best/most important to your educational career/experience
- -students will cross stage, name announced, student write up will be read, a statement acknowledging the graduate is receiving a «French Immersion Dual Dogwood » will be made.

Trustee Voice:

- -Hearing that parents/students feel that students have not been recognized in the past and that they are currently not being adequately recognized
